

Paper Roll Birdfeeder

Pair this craft with a walk in the neighborhood where you keep an eye out for any birds or other wildlife; or pair it with spcaLA's DIY City Wildlife presentation, available for download on our website! If you have a cat at home, you can also try to hang your bird feeder outside a window your cat frequents. Your birdfeeder can then become a new entertainment system for your cat too!

MATERIALS:

- Paper towel or toilet paper roll
- Yarn, twine, or ribbon
- Hole puncher
- Peanut butter or substitute
- Knife or spreading utensil
- Bird seed or a bird-friendly cereal like cheerios

INSTRUCTIONS:

Before getting started, we recommend laying down newspaper or a table cloth for easy clean up!

Step 1: Punch a hole on opposite sides of the roll, about an inch from the top.

Step 2: Run the yarn through each punched hole.

Step 3: Spread an even layer of peanut butter all over the outside of the paper roll, starting right below the punched holes.

Step 4: Pour a generous amount of bird seed onto your surface. Roll the paper roll around in the bird seed until fully covered. It's ready to hang outside!
