



Treats Course

Create a fun course for your pet's treats! Your pet will watch their treat zig and zag until it reaches its destination - your pet's mouth!

MATERIALS:

- Paper rolls
- Painter's tape
- Pet treats
- Optional: Paint and paint brush

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Take your paper rolls and arrange them on a table top to plan how you would like the treat course to go. There are endless options depending on the number of paper rolls you are using. The more paper rolls, the more interesting your treat course can get.
- Diagonally cut the tops of each paper roll. This will allow for treats to fall inside.
- Optional: get even more creative and paint the paper rolls, adding some fun color to your course. Allow the paper rolls to fully dry before using.
- Tape your paper rolls onto a wall and make sure they are secure. The painter's tape will allow you to do this without damaging your wall paint.
- Give your course a test run without your pet. Make sure the treat zigs and zags all the way down.
- Finally, using treats (or even your pet's kibble), get your dog's attention and show them that you are dropping a treat into the top of the course. Watch your pet figure out what is happening and enjoy! We recommend starting off with a simple course and if you and your dog enjoy this, you can create a more complex course.
